COMMUNITY IMPACT AND ENGAGEMENT

FUNDING SOLUTIONS

- Awarded grants to 40 organizations across Western Massachusetts totaling \$275,000.
- 4th Cohort of Young Women’s Initiative (YWI) graduates.
- Young Women’s Initiative 4th Annual Career Conversations hosted virtually.
- Awarded scholarships to 18 participants to attend 2 sessions of Holyoke Community College’s Women’s Leadership Series with priority given to BIWOC individuals.
- 10 episodes of Power Women Hour, featuring women of color entrepreneurs, were produced and shared with almost 800 total views to date.



CREATING COMMUNITY PARTNERSHIPS

- Hosted regional convening to unveil Economic Security Hub work in March with 48 attendees and dozens of views of the recorded event.
- Convened monthly domestic and sexual violence service providers in roundtable meetings.
- Co-hosted two Rural Economic Taskforce meetings for survivors of violence run by Amy Waldman of the Department of Public Health.
- Hosted monthly Women Heads of Nonprofits Leadership Breakfasts virtually.



ELEVATING COLLECTIVE POWER

- Curated the Peace, Power, and Prosperity for Women and Girls discussion to center expert information from Dr. Valerie Young, Dr. Silke Staab, and Dr. Kathleen Szegda.
- Hosted public, community partner “Wait... What?!” discussions on civic responsibilities, evictions and the eviction moratorium, and racial disparities in maternal health.
- Partnered with Dr. Nayla Bahri to offer an interactive workshop on how to plan and design a career that leverages strength and connects to a sense of purpose.
- Partnered with MassMutual to host Perspectives from the C-Suite: Women’s Leadership Panel on International Women’s Day.
- Hosted Amplify! workshops for nonprofits that serve women and girls centering data storytelling and leadership succession planning.
- Launched newsletter centering resources to support women- and girl-serving organizations.
- Published 26 stories about Women’s Fund work including 1 opinion editorial and a feature on BusinessWest’s BusinessTalk podcast.

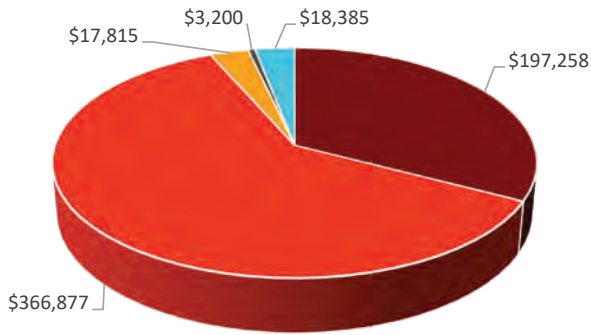

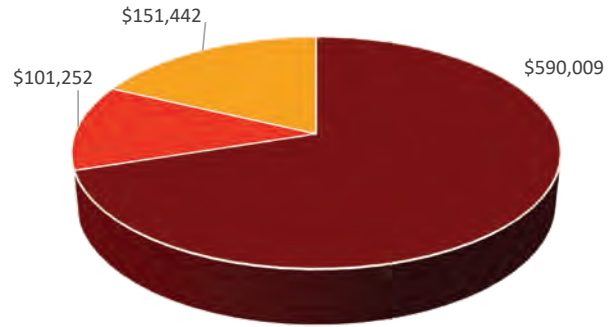
